EPRC's 61st annual meeting will focus on Grid Resource Adequacy and Resilience. The Organization of MISO States will hold their annual spring workshop with EPRC the morning of May 14, and our collaboration will extend to a joint workshop the morning of May 15, when we will present a generation technology showcase.

The afternoon of May 15, the EPRC meeting will commence with keynote speaker **Mr. Clair Moeller, the President and COO of MISO**. He will be followed by a presentation on nuclear power as a part of planning for resource adequacy, by **Dr. Mark Nutt, Manager of the Nuclear Sector at Pacific Northwest National Laboratories**.

We will hear a presentation by **Mr. Ryan Janda, the Branch Head of FEMA, on the role of the FEMA Building Resilience and Communities (BRIC) Program in developing resilient infrastructure**. Following his presentation, we will have several short descriptions of current resilience projects at ISU, ranging from the Montezuma microgrid, to the development of new, lighter weight conductor materials at Ames Lab.

Our poster reception and competition will provide a comprehensive overview of power-related research at ISU.

The banquet speaker **Dr. Debra Lew, Associate Director of the Energy Systems Integration Group. Her tentative title is "Decarbonizing the Last 10% of the Grid"**.
