Jean H. Brittain was a founder and CEO of Calimetrix, a company dedicated to the development of quantitative MRI test objects. Previously, she was a Senior Scientist at the University of Wisconsin. She also spent 13 years at GE Healthcare's Applied Science Lab (ASL). While at ASL, she founded the ASL-West facility and research group and was Chief Scientist and Manager of a scientific team that collaborated with leading academic researchers to develop new MRI applications, some of which are part of GE product and are used in patient care worldwide. She completed her M.S., Ph.D., and postdoctoral studies at Stanford University, was granted 19 U.S. patents, and was elected a Fellow of the International Society for Magnetic Resonance in Medicine.
