Dean Feisel has been very active in professional societies, serving as president or chair of various national and international societies. He is the recipient of many awards, including the Iowa State Professional Achievement Citation in Engineering, New York State Engineer of the Year, the national NSPE Award, the IEEE Centennial and Millennium medals and various achievement awards. He was elected Fellow of IEEE, ASEE and NSPE. As an electrical engineer, Feisel has made significant contributions to laboratory teaching through the development of fundamental objectives for laboratories.
